

**PART B: MONDAY EVENING  
WOMEN'S PHRF FLEET  
SPECIFIC SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

**1 ELIGIBILITY**

- 1.1 Boats will be skippered and crewed by women.
- 1.2 Man on Board - No more than one man may be on board, provided he is either the owner or a representative of the owner. When racing, and until the boat has finished the race and cleared the finish line or retired, the man shall not give any advice or assistance, physical or verbal, to the crew or skipper. Infringement of this Sailing Instruction will be subject to a scoring penalty in accordance with RRS 44.3(c).

**2 CLASS FLAG**

- 2.1 The class signal will be Code Flag "F".

**3 TIME LIMIT**

- 3.1 RRS 35 is modified by: "Boats failing to finish within 60 minutes after the first boat in their PHRF fleet will be scored Did Not Finish."

**4 PRIZES**

- 4.1 Prizes for the top 3 boats in each division will be awarded.
- 4.2 Prizes for Club series are defined in Annex B1 of these Sailing Instructions, and will be presented at the Clubs' awards night.
- 4.3 Prizes for Interclub series are defined in Annex B2 of these Sailing Instructions, and will be presented at the Interclub Club awards night.
